



Youth Meeting

An 8-15 day camp that features an individual theme which allows young people to explore intercultural issues. The program builds leadership and organization skills, while continuing to promote CISV values and involvement. It's usually held during a school holiday.

Education Goals:

1. Explore education themes linked to the CISV content areas.
2. Raise awareness and stimulate critical thinking.
3. Increase personal development in group situations.
4. Generate interest in individuals towards their daily personal environment.

Structure of the program:

Individual delegates will travel on their own to and from the program. They will not have a leader to take them however there will be hosting staff who will facilitate and act as a caregiver for the youth.

It is possible that there may be more than one person from Canada attending. You will contact the other individuals from Canada to discuss your Cultural Activity.

There will be representatives from many different countries there.

There will be four to five staff members at the camp.

Activities:

The camp will feature activities that are centered around the theme and will teach a variety of educational components. Activities will be theoretical, practical, active, quiet, individual, group, outdoor, indoor, educational, fun, and present opportunities for cultural exchange.

Some participants may have already participated in a Village or an Step Up and be comfortable with CISV programs. For others this may be their first CISV experience. The staff and leaders will organize a camp that is welcoming and inclusive for everyone.
